Pagers, Cell Phones, and other Electronic Devices

Students in 9 – 12th grades will be allowed to carry cell phones and/or pagers at school with the stipulations listed below. Students who bring electronic devices on campus do so at their own risk. The schools are not responsible for call charges or lost, stolen, or damaged electronic devices or accessories.

1. Students shall be allowed to use cell phones, pagers before and after school and during the student's lunch period only.
2. At all times, including but not limited to class time, cell phones and/or pagers shall be turned off, completely off, in all modes.
3. Cell phones and/or pagers used during class time, or whose devices are activated in class or in the halls, shall be confiscated and turned into the students Administrator. The following will be the disciplinary action taken:
 - a. ***First Offense*** – confiscation of the items and parent is responsible for pick-up from the office during normal school business hours.
 - b. ***Second Offense*** – confiscated item is kept in the locked cabinet in attendance for 30 days.
 - c. ***Third Offense*** – confiscated item is kept in the locked cabinet for the remainder of the school year.
 - d. ***Subsequent Offenses*** – student is suspended.

If a student refuses to surrender an electronic device to a teacher or administrator, he or she is subject to immediate suspension.
