DRESS POLICY:

- The Walters’ Administration maintains the right to use their discretion to prohibit any attire which disrupts, distracts, or interferes with the orderly maintenance of the campus.
- Walters’ designed hats are the only ones allowed. No other hat is to be worn anywhere on the Walters’ campus.
- Hair nets are not allowed.
- Sunglasses are not to be worn in the classroom.
- No sagging or baggy pants. Pants are to be worn at waist level.
- No open-toed footwear or shoes with wheels are permitted.
- No article of clothing is allowed which exposes any part of a student’s torso from the knees to the shoulders, except for shorts, which may be worn mid-thigh length. Undergarments should not be exposed.
- No muscle shirts, tank tops, bare-midriff tops, and/or excessively low-cut tops are allowed.
- No halter tops, tube tops or spaghetti strap shirts are to be worn.
- No clothing which contains logos or inscriptions related to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, hate, violence or discriminatory behaviors may be worn or brought to school.
- No cologne, perfumes, or aerosol sprays/cans are allowed on campus.
- Pajamas or sleepwear are not to be worn to school except in the case of a spirit week activity.
- Blankets are not allowed at school. Students should have a jacket in cold weather for warmth.
- Dangerous items or jewelry are not allowed.
- No bandanas or bandana print attire or accessories are permitted on campus.
- Any clothing determined to be ‘gang type dress’ is not allowed per Fremont Unified School District dress code and mandated by the Superintendent.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES AND CELL PHONE POLICY:

- No electronic devices, games (PSP, Game boys), cameras, laser pointers, MP3 players or iPods.
- Per Fremont Unified School District Board Policy, students will be allowed to carry cell phones to be used before and after school only. Cell phones must be completely turned off (not on silent mode). The school is not responsible for call charges or lost, stolen or damaged electronic devices or accessories. Inappropriate cell phone usage will initiate the progressive discipline policy, including confiscation, parent contact and suspension as adopted by Fremont Unified School District.

THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OR THEFT OF ANY OF THESE ITEMS WHILE ON SCHOOL PREMISES OR BEFORE OR AFTER SCHOOL. THE SCHOOL WILL NOT REPLACE THESE ITEMS.
