



Oliveira Elementary School



Students in grades Transitional Kindergarten through Grade Six are required to wear uniform beginning Wednesday August 31, 2016.

During the 2015-16 school year the parents of the Oliveira student body were asked to vote on whether or not Oliveira would adopt a uniform policy starting 16-17 for the next 3 academic years. The parent voting results were in favor of a school uniform policy. A parent uniform committee, Oliveira Ambassador Council student body, and a staff/parent forum provided input and feedback to create this uniform policy. The uniform policy is based on the values of school unity, safety, and practicality. The color scheme is based on Oliveira's school colors; white and light blue. All district dress code policies remain in effect (BP 5132/AR 5132).

Oliveira School Uniform Revised April 2016

Uniforms must be worn every Monday-Thursday at school. Every Friday is a casual dress day.

Shirts and Tops

Colors: White, light blue, navy blue and black (*one solid color with no embellishments, writing or designs*)

Types:

- Any type of shirt maybe worn (e.g. t-shirt, button-up, henley, collared, etc.)
- All tops must have a sleeve (e.g. cap sleeves, short sleeves, or long short sleeves as per Board policy)
- Any Oliveira school shirt may be worn.
- Solid colored white, light blue, navy blue and black (cardigan sweaters and hoodie sweatshirts may be worn on top of shirts).

Bottoms

Colors: Navy blue, khaki, black and dark grey (*one solid color with no embellishments, writing or designs*)

Types:

- Pants, skirts, shorts, skorts, capris, jumpers, dresses and athletic shorts. All bottoms must abide the FUSD dress code policy and be no shorter than finger tip length when arms are extended down to the side.
- Tights may or may not be worn under skirts, dresses, or shorts.
- **No** denim jeans, shirts, skirts or shirts may be worn.

Footwear

- All students must bring PE appropriate shoes on days they have PE and change into them before PE.
- Students may **not** wear sandals, thongs, flip flops, clogs, crocs, heely's or cleats. No raised heels, wedged or elevated soles.
- Rain boots may be worn on rainy days. Students must bring PE appropriate shoes to change into.
- Boots must have tread and non-slip soles. Students must bring PE appropriate shoes to change into for PE.

Hats

- Hats are worn only outdoors for sun protection. Head coverings for religious and/or cultural reasons are permitted.

Outerwear

- Any type of coat or jacket may be worn outside.

Casual Dress Fridays: Every Friday is a casual dress day. Students must still wear clothing following the FUSD dress code policy (BP 5132/AR 5132—available on FUSD website).

Spirit Days: Spirit Days set by Oliveira Ambassador Council and are themed dress days usually falling on a Friday. These days may: Halloween, Crazy Hair Day, Twin Day, etc. They will be announced at the start of the school year.

Oliveira Uniform Community Closet: Oliveira has a community closet on campus where parents can purchase gently used uniform clothing. The Community Closet is staffed by volunteers. Tops are \$1 and bottoms are \$2. All the money is donated back to the school. You can also donate gently used uniform items for resale. It's a great way to recycle, save money and give back to the school.

OPT-OUT Dress Code Revised 2016: Students who choose to opt-out of the Oliveira School Uniform Policy must fill out a Uniform Dress Exemption. Parents who choose to opt-out of the Oliveira School Uniform Policy must adhere the FUSD dress code policy and opt-out policy (BP 5132/AR 5132—available on FUSD website).

Footwear: Students who opt-out of the Oliveira School Uniform Policy must follow the same footwear policy stated above in the Oliveira School Uniform Policy.
